

Love of Elohim!!!

(Part 2)

Have you ever owned something, stored it away and then never used it, yet you always knew it was there and then one day you had this great idea to actually take it out and put it use?

Elohim had already created all of the universe and all the Malakim (Angels), that all praised and worshipped Elohim at that time.

Elohim had created them with Divine Knowledge and Understanding. Yet Elohim wanted to create mankind who would be a little lower then the Malakim (Angels) in all ways but gave them a gift that if they used it correctly would elevate them to a position greater than the Malakim (Angels).

Joh 14:15

“If you love Me, you shall guard My commands”.

For 99% of the world's current 7 billion people, which includes Yahudites (Jews), christianity, islam, hinduism, buddhism and various other religious groups, it is truly a concept that is difficult for them to grasp or have a desire to do.

2Ti 3:2-5

For men shall be lovers of self, lovers of money, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, thankless, wrong-doers, unloving, unforgiving, slanderers, without self-control, fierce, haters of good, betrayers, reckless, puffed up, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of Elohim, having a form of reverence but denying its power. And turn away from these!

Yet, Elohim clearly demonstrated Their Love and Commandments to mankind from the beginning of human history.

1Jn 2:3-7

And by this we know that we know Him, if we guard His commands.

The one who says, "I know Him," and does not guard His commands, is a liar, and the truth is not in him.

But whoever guards His Word, truly the love of Elohim has been perfected in him. By this we know that we are in Him.

The one who says he stays in Him ought himself also to walk, even as He walked.

Beloved, I write no fresh command to you, but an old command which you have had from the beginning. The old command is the Word which you heard from the beginning.

It is us who constantly find ways not to learn the greatest lesson ever taught. "Love Me and Keep My Commandments" and you will become higher than the Malakim (Angels) and live forever with Elohim and learn everything Elohim desires to teach us. So that we can experience things we could never dream of with our current limited intelligence and understanding.

Hmmm! Let me see. Do what Elohim says, according to The Word or don't observe what Elohim says. Not a very hard choice for me to make. It might be hard to implement, but what I have found to be true is that to the people he gives, if they respond, Elohim will give more and this formula actually works as we grow and grow in Elohim until it is time for us to receive our final reward.

Mat 7:7-8

"For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it shall be opened.

Jas 1:5-6

If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of Elohim, who gives to all generously and without reproach, and it shall be given to him.

But he should ask in belief, not doubting, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven and tossed by the wind.

So, where many never take the opportunity to learn the principles and precepts that Elohim have given to mankind, I thank Elohim for giving me the chance to take the baby steps required to get to the point where Elohim permeates my being more and more and more. Until at some point, "I will be in this world but not of this world".

Pro 3:5-6

**Trust in יהוה with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding;
Know Him in all your ways, And He makes all your paths straight.**

I know I could have failed miserably and I can not tell you why Elohim chose me as he does others, but He did choose me and I was fortunate enough to respond and watch the process in action.

If you would follow the words of the Emissary Shaul (Apostle Paul) who told us to imitate Shaul who imitates Mashiach or if you will believe that what I tell you is the truth, then you will really start to enjoy your own unique relationship with Elohim who is your Divine Creator.

Jas 4:10

1Pe 5:6-7

Humble yourselves, then, under the mighty hand of Elohim, so that He exalts you in due time, casting all your worry upon Him, for He is concerned about you.

Yes - I know some of you are where I am at or possibly further along, but so many others are not and need to be helped so they can learn stand on their own.

In this manner Elohim's Love is demonstrated in mankind.

We are told that a dog is a man's best friend.

Why?

- 1. Dogs were created lower than man and can not achieve nor have but basic intelligence.**
- 2. Dogs are loyal and usually love their owner and follows their owners commands.**
- 3. Dogs are even more obedient when trained properly by it's owner.**

4. **Dogs will usually sacrifice it's own life protecting it's owner.**
5. **Dogs gets rewarded for being good and punished for being bad.**
6. **Dogs experiences forgiveness until the point where it becomes disobedient or to hard to handle and then it either severely punished or sent away.**
7. **Dogs have no opportunity to have eternal life like we do because they do not have the eternal spirit of Elohim. Such as was given to man.**

Seems to me that Elohim has created mankind similar with regards to our relationship to Elohim. The big differences is that we have an eternal spirit and we can increase in intelligence far beyond that of a dog. We also have the special gift of "Free Will" that dogs do not get to have.

Note: This is just a very simple and crude example to use, but appears to me as being very effective.

Those of us that are disobedient can end up being sent to obedience school or all the way to being put to sleep and then permanently crispy crittered (eternal separation from Elohim).

Those of us that are obedient can end up being sent to prep school and all the way to the greatest graduation party in all of history.
